

Warrior Golf Club Membership Handbook

Date: October 01, 2009

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1. Types of Memberships, Initiation & Dues

Bronze

Note: Bronze Membership is an annual membership. WGC has the right to discontinue this membership in December each year. The price will be set in December for the following year.

Yearly fee: \$450.00 for 2010 (Due at sign-up)

Membership fee is for a calendar year

Receives \$10.00 off the regular green fee

Tee times 8 days in advance

Range Package available (\$350.00/yr)

Member only golf tournaments

Reduced Handicap fee \$35/yr

Charge Account available with monthly credit card draft

Weekday (Mon - Thurs) Membership

Initiation \$100 and 1yr dues (\$85/mo.) payable at signup - \$1120.00

Range Package available (\$350.00/yr)

Green fee \$15 for 18 holes, \$7.50 for 9 holes

Membership fee is for a calendar year

Tee times 8 days in advance

Member only golf tournaments

Reduced Handicap fee \$35/yr

Charge Account available with monthly credit card draft

After the first year dues may be paid monthly

Senior (over 60) Weekday (Mon - Thurs) Membership

Initiation \$100 and 1yr dues (\$60/mo.) payable at signup - \$820.00

Range Package available (\$350.00/yr)

Green fee \$15 for 18 holes, \$7.50 for 9 holes

Membership fee is for a calendar year

Tee times 8 days in advance

Member only golf tournaments

Reduced Handicap fee \$35/yr

Charge Account available with monthly credit card draft

After the first year dues may be paid monthly

Platinum Membership – DISCONTINUED 12-31-2009

Diamond (All Existing Members) Membership

Single member Monthly Dues \$155

Green fee \$15 for 18 holes, \$7.50 for 9 holes

Grill Discount 20%

Unlimited Range Balls

Free CGA Handicap Card

Member Charge Account

\$5 discount on monthly dues (after first year) with credit card draft

Additional Family members may be added:

Spouse - \$30

Children (13-19)-\$45, (20-25)-\$60, (26-30)-\$75, (31-35)-\$125

Brother or Sister - \$125

2. Pearl to Diamond Transfers

Membership will transfer automatically after 2 years.

3. Member Tee Times

Members are allowed 14 days in advance. If cancellation is needed, please call the pro shop at least 24hrs in advance to allow WGC an opportunity to fill the tee time.

4. Guest Policy

Each member may bring up to six (6) guests per month. A non-member is eligible for only two (2) guest rates per month. Please adhere to this policy.

A non-member will not receive the guest rate unless the member signs in.

Guest Rates are available in the Pro Shop

5. Tournament Fees

All unpaid tournament fees will be put on the member's account on the last day of the tournament

6. One time 2010 “Yearly Prepayment of Dues”

During the 29 days from December 1st through December 29th a Diamond member may pay the next years dues and receive a discount of 1 month’s dues. The member may pay for 11 months and receive the 12th free.

If during the year a member is placed on “medical leave” and their dues are put on hold the member is not eligible for “Yearly Prepayment of Dues”

7. Member (Credit Card Draft) Charge accounts

Credit Card Draft Accounts (\$5 discount on monthly dues)

Card will be drafted on the 16th on the month. If the card is declined it will be drafted again on the 20th. If declined the \$5 discount will be removed.

8. Account Billing Practices

- Anyone not paying their account balance by the 16th of the month (30 days from billing) will have a finance charge of \$15.00 added to their account.
- Monthly dues are entered on member’s account on the 16th of the month
- Monthly dues are billed in advance. Example: Dues billed on the 16th of May are for the month of June and due by June 5th. (This is the same way the dues have been billed since we opened).
- Credit Card Member’s account balance is drafted from their credit card on the 16th of the month
- Members with an email address will receive an invoice of their monthly dues
- Members with an email address will receive an invoice for grill charges weekly to biweekly
- Members with an email address will receive a monthly statement around the 16th of the month
- Members without an email address will not receive an invoice for monthly dues
- The POS# on the statement is for pro shop purchases. Members may receive a receipt at the time of purchase. This number may be used in the pro shop to obtain a copy of the receipt at a later date.

9. Medical Leave and Hardship

Warrior has always tried to work with any member that has had to deal with issues that were beyond their control and will continue to do so. Any member that wishes to go on Medical or Hardship Leave must meet with Membership Officer (Gerald) and fill out a request form. In most cases the form will be accepted or denied at that time or within 24hrs. After the form has been accepted the member will lose all membership privileges until the member meets with the membership officer (Gerald) and fills out a reinstatement form as before.

- Warrior reserves the right to grant “Leaves” or “Reinstatements” at our discretion
- “Medical Leave” will not be granted for less than 3 months
- “Hardship Leave” will not be granted for less than 3 months
- If a member is on Medical Leave and plays golf at another golf course, they will NOT be reinstated. Their membership is terminated.
- Member must call Membership Officer (Gerald) with a “progress report” every 2 months to keep their request active.
- Member will not be eligible for “Yearly Prepayment of Dues” in Section 7.

10. Non-Payment of Dues

Dues are posted in your account on the 16th of each month and payable by the 5th of the next month.

If dues are not paid by the 16th there will be a finance charge of \$15.00 added to the dues for the next month.

If dues are not received by the 1st of the next month the membership will be put on hold until all dues are paid.

11. Reinstatement after Termination

An ex-Member must apply for reinstatement with the Membership Officer (Gerald). Warrior reserves the right to deny reinstatement of any former member.

12. Checking in at the Pro Shop

All golfers are expected to sign in at the Pro Shop before play.

Any member playing golf or practicing on the course after hours that has not signed in or notified the pro shop (when and where) will receive a one time warning. If any damage was caused due to chemicals being applied by maintenance these cost must be paid within 24 hours or charges will be filed against the member. On the second offense membership will be terminated and damages will be handled in the same manner.

13. Golf Cart Usage

Please report any malfunctions of the golf carts as soon as possible so that cart can be removed from service until it is repaired. Please make a note of the cart number that is in question. Every effort is made to keep our golf carts maintained for your safety and ours.

It is the responsibility of any member that damages a golf cart to report the damages to the pro shop. You will be only be charged for the repair.

If an incident is not reported it will be assumed that the damage was deliberate and charges will be filled with the police department. If the responsible party is a member their membership will be revoked. Any unpaid damages will be turned over to our attorney.

14. Course Damage

Any member who willfully causes damage to Warrior Golf Club property will have their membership revoked; membership will be terminated, and banned from WGC property indefinitely. Any damages will be filed with the police department.

15. Food & Beverages

All food and beverages are to be purchased from Champions Grill at WGC. No outside coolers are allowed on the property.

All members and guest consuming alcohol will be expected to conduct themselves as adults. Sales to individuals will be monitored by our staff and because of the liability accepted by WGC to sell beer and wine, overindulgence will not be tolerated.
